

FaSS or UKSF?

Which is the right scheme for you?

If you are based in **England**, you may be eligible to apply for either the Fisheries and Seafood Scheme (FaSS) or the UK Seafood Fund (UKSF), depending on the type of project you want to deliver.

FaSS	UKSF
England-only	UK-wide
Funds fishing activities / infrastructure / co-operative projects / protecting the environment / diversification / health and safety	Funds science / infrastructure / training & skills
Lower-value projects (up to £250k provided)	Higher-value projects
Individual organisations and co-operatives	Individual organisations and co-operatives

Depending on your type of organisation and the scheme you are applying under, you may need to pay for a proportion of the project yourself. This could be your own money, a loan from a bank or credit union, or a grant from a local authority.
